Participant information

- 1.) Participants will need to bring a **sleeping bag, pillow, towel** and any personal items. Limit luggage to one medium sized bag (not including sleeping bag). If possible please also bring a water bottle, cup or mug of some sort which can be identified as yours for use throughout the weekend.
- 2.) Payment for conference if this is not completed in advance. Cheque or money order made out to Change for Children Association for \$45.00 without transport or \$55.00 with transport.
- 3.) All food and snacks will be provided, however there is a small store at the camp to purchase items.
- 4.) All participants will need to bring the conference waiver form signed by their parent/guardian and their personal Alberta healthcare card
- 5.) Musical instrument if you have one
- 6.) Information about social justice activities in your school or community
- 7.) Parents and teachers are welcome to attend but must also register
- 8.) Change for Children staff, board and volunteers will provide adult supervision for the duration of the conference to ensure the safe and positive participation of all participants. All participants will be expected to contribute to a healthy environment and there will be zero tolerance for alcohol, drugs or any behavior that is harmful to other persons or the environment. There will be separate male and female dorms and supervision in each.
- 9.) Transportation from Edmonton will leave at 12:00 on March 30, 2007
Transportation from Red Deer on March 30, 2007 at 2:00pm
Departure locations TBA and transportation is provided by Golden Arrow Bus Lines. Bus will leave to return at 11:30am on April 1, 2007.
